She has performed lead roles with Opera per tutti, Lyric Opera Cleveland, Opera Cleveland on Tour and is Music Director of St. Peter's Lutheran Church and the head of the Voice Department at The Music Settlement.



Tenor Matthew Jones has appeared as soloist with the Savannah Philharmonic, Stow Symphony Orchestra, Great Lakes Light Opera, Opera Circle, Duffy Liturgical Arts, and Trinity Chamber Orchestra. In addition to teaching at The Music Settlement, Matthew sings with the Cleveland Chamber Choir, and Trinity Chamber Singers and Cathedral Choir at Trinity Cathedral.



Accompanist Adam Whiting is a coach/accompanist at the Cleveland School of the Arts and The Music Settlement and was a staff accompanist at the Cleveland Institute of Music where he earned a double-master's in piano performance and accompanying. After 15 years in Cleveland, he considers himself a transplant, but still spends summers in the Pacific Northwest to accompany the Oregon Suzuki Institute and the Japan Seattle Suzuki Institute.
