School Year Programs

18 MONTHS-TWO YEAR OLDS

This beginning classroom experience is for children who will be 18 months before the first day of school and two-years old by Sept. 30. Children will enjoy early learning through games, art, music and activity. The amount of time spent on separation is determined by the needs of the child. Option of three-day or five-day program..



THREE YEAR OLDS

This class is a wonderful experience for three year

olds. Children participate in fun, educational activities, playtime, art projects

and music. There is an emphasis on letter and number recognition and exposure to phonics and pre-reading skills. *Five-day program.*

PRE-K

Our Pre-K class is a well rounded program combining socialization, Kindergarten readiness and fun.
